## Childcare Certificate III in Children's Services CHC30402

After completing the Nanny Award many students continue to study the Certificate III in Children's Services. You can join at this level if you have completed the pre requisites required. This is a great opportunity to make new friends and colleagues.

The 'prac' focus changes from the home care situation to that of a child care centre. You will be working with larger groups of children. The number of children will vary according to the room you work in and the size of the centre. Your 'prac' may consist of two days per week for 5 weeks and 2 full week blocks. Through this hands-on experience you will get to know how a centre works, the role of an assistant in a centre and the great team experience of a child care centre. This qualification will allow you to work as a Child Care Assistant.

The Certificate III course will make you think a little more about children's growth and development. You will learn how to take observations on children and how to keep parents informed. You will learn the joy of children's literature and discover how fascinating and creative young children are. **enhance training** Certificate III graduates are sought after as Child Care Assistants and Nannies.

At the completion of this course, you will be eligible to work as a child care assistant in a child care centre or as a nanny in a family's home.

### ***Course Duration***

Certificate III in Children's Services is a full-time course that is 3 months in duration with 35 contact hours, five days per week.

### ***Practical Experience***

As part of your Child Care studies, you will receive the opportunity to put your theoretical skills into practice in a workplace.

As part of your course you will spend 22 days in a child care centre working with children of all ages. This placement will be organised for you by ENHANCE TRAINING.
